**INTERVENTION OF CANPAR HOLDINGS LTD. ("CANPAR")**

1. Canpar owns freehold mines and minerals and petroleum and natural gas ("P&NG") in Western Canada. In particular, Canpar holds title to a gross overriding royalty ("GORR") covering all P&NG produced from property described as 8-34-26 W4M. This property covers the coalbed methane well licences 1383132, 1383134, 1383136 and 138137 shown on page 4 of the Board's Notice of Hearing dated June 23, 2006.
2. Canpar disposed of its interest in "coal" in these lands under an agreement entered into in 1982 with TransAlta Utilities Corporation, as purchaser. This agreement did not include coalbed methane and Canpar did not dispose of its interest in the coalbed methane existing within the coal seams.
3. In the event that the Board determines legal entitlement of coalbed methane being produced or intended to be produced from these wells, Canpar's rights under its GORR may be adversely affected.
4. Canpar has a direct and substantial interest in matters related to this Application. Canpar believes that its interest in this proceeding is as an "other third-party natural gas holder" as set out in the Board's Notice of Hearing dated June 23, 2006. Canpar therefore requests that it be granted intervener status.
5. Canpar intends to appear at the hearing and reserves the right to submit information requests, file evidence, conduct cross examination and make final argument.
