The Alberta Energy and Utilities Board, (EUB) is currently reviewing these applications by Devon Canada Corporation (Devon), requesting approval to drill wells from the above surface locations. The proposed wells are to produce coal bed methane.

We understand Devon has contacted you to describe its applied for project, and to discuss any concerns that you may have in relation to the proposal. We understand that you may have outstanding concerns related to the proposed application. The EUB must have sufficient information to understand the nature of your concerns and your relationship to the proposed development. This will allow the EUB to determine the best course of action to address your concerns and engage the appropriate decision-making process. The EUB is committed to provide both the public and industry with an effective regulatory process to identify and address concerns. Action can include providing additional information and assistance from EUB staff, conducting field inspections and sharing results, different forms of dispute resolutions and possibly a hearing. Therefore, should you have a legally recognized interest in this application and want to make a submission, please state in writing your reasons for objecting to the application within **14 days of receiving this notice**. If your submission is not received within the specified time period, the application by Devon may be processed and the necessary approvals issued.

In this regard the Board must make a determination of the standing of the person(s) making the objection. Standing is the right of a person to participate in a hearing or other decision-making process, which may result in a decision affecting the person's rights. This means you have to provide the Board with some information to show that you are entitled to exercise a legally recognized interest with respect to the land in question or use of it and that the decision of the Board may directly and adversely affect that interest. You should provide sufficient information so that the Board is able to clearly understand your position and make a reasonable decision at this stage of the application that you may be directly and adversely affected by a project.

The Board will consider that you have a legally recognized right if you own, lease or otherwise have a direct legal interest in lands on which the proposed facility is to be located or on adjacent lands or other lands which may, in the Board's opinion, be impacted by a proposed project. In considering whether you may be an affected party, the Board will evaluate certain criteria including:

- Is your health or safety affected, or property rights or other economic interests? Examples of effects that may be considered by the Board include: negative interference with livelihood or commercial activity on the land, devaluation of land and house, damage to property, concerns for safety of persons or animals, negative effects on health from contaminants in water, air, soil or noise.
- Are you affected in a different way or to a greater degree than members of the general public?
- Are you able to show a reasonable and direct connection between the activity complained of and the rights or interests alleged to be affected?


In outlining your concerns associated with the proposed project, it is important that the Board understand how you want the Board to respond to the project application. Your submission should contain a summary of the facts that you believe will assist the Board in reaching a decision and the reasons you believe the Board should decide in a particular manner.
