



5. Two facts are clearly evident from the above two sets of data:
- a) even though the pools are near each other, the pool pressures are significantly different, thus confirming that these pools are completely isolated from each other.
 - b) there is no evidence of the pressure equilibration postulated by Petro-Canada.

Conclusion: There is overwhelming evidence that each pool will have its own individual average reservoir pressure, and there is no evidence that the region will equilibrate at a weighted average pressure.
