Following the Court of Appeal's leave decision issued February 26, 2004 the Board received letters from Paramount Energy Trust, Calpine Canada Resources Company and Devon Canada Corporation requesting that the Board exclude additional wells that were the subject of the shut-in order issued pursuant to the Chard Leismer Decision.

The Board has today initiated a process that could result in a hearing to review a number of wells with Wabiskaw-McMurray perforated intervals that were approved for gas production or not required to be shut-in under EUB Decision 2003-23. Therefore, the Board will not consider changing the production status of the same intervals in the same wells as part of the hearing commencing March 10, 2004. Parties should refer to the Board's letter setting out the proposed review hearing to determine whether a particular perforated interval will be considered in the March 10th hearing.
