### Publication of *Directive 057: Fencing and Site Access Requirements for Oil and Gas Facilities*

In *Bulletin 2007-45*, the Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB) announced that the draft *Directive 057: Fencing and Site Access Requirements for Oil and Gas Facilities* was available on the ERCB Web site for stakeholder comment and feedback until January 25, 2008.

Licensees are advised that the ERCB has taken all comments and feedback into consideration and made changes to the directive that establish more detailed requirements for the limiting of access to oil and gas facilities.

*Directive 057* introduces new requirements for fencing and security that are applicable to ERCB-regulated oil and gas facilities. These new requirements are in addition to existing ERCB fencing and security requirements; together they will ensure an increased level of protection for Albertans. The intent of the directive is to reduce the possibility of incidents of vandalism or accidents involving the public at facilities by increasing security at those facilities.
