

ERCB Enforcement of Low Risk Noncompliance	Description	Implications	Approximate Period Between Actions
Notice of Low Risk Noncompliance	Volumetric Deficiency Invoice is sent electronically to Ministry Invoices and Statements, accessible through the Registry menu.	Companies must correct the noncompliance event by the next ERCB monthly volumetric deadline or must request an Enforcement Action review of the invoice from the Production Accounting group within 15 calendar days of the ERCB invoice date. Failure to correct the noncompliance event or request an Enforcement Action review from the Notice of Low Risk Noncompliance will result in the company being placed on Low Risk Enforcement Action.	30 days
Low Risk Enforcement Action	A letter is sent to the company, at the VP level advising the deadline for corrections. In addition to correcting the error, the company may also be required to provide a written explanation addressing failure to respond and detailing steps to prevent future occurrences.	If the noncompliance event is not corrected and the company is not actively working with the ERCB by the next ERCB volumetric filing deadline, the company will be contacted by ERCB to discuss the situation, and may result in one or more of the following enforcement actions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Noncompliance fees • Partial or full suspension • Suspension and/or cancellation of permit/license, or approval • Refer status: focused or global 	30 days
