Re: Amendment to Request to Shut-In Clearwater Gas Production in the Fisher & Moore Area's Filed 2005-06-30.

Dear Ms. Law:

This letter is an amendment to the list of wells Canadian Natural Resources Limited (CNRL) is requesting to be shut-in because they are negatively impacting future bitumen recovery and development. These changes reflect the following:

1. New wells in existing pools not included in the original application¹.
2. The withdrawal of CNRL's objection to Clearwater gas production in a specified area of section 68-5W4².

Figure 1 shows the gas wells listed in the original application along with new additional wells. Figure 2 shows the specified area that CNRL has withdrawn its objection to Clearwater gas production.
