**Re: ERCB Proceeding 169  
Applications by Sunshine Oil Sands Ltd. (Application No. 1613543) and Total E & P  
Canada Ltd. (Application No. 1616123) for the shut-in of gas production from 105 wells,  
and an application by Paramount Energy Operating Corporation (Application No.  
1506272) to produce gas from one well, in and around the Liege Wabiskaw O Pool**

Dear Sirs:

On September 3, 2009, the Board issued a Notice of Hearing for the above applications. The Notice of Hearing included a schedule for filing submissions and set September 30<sup>th</sup> as the date upon which submissions are due from the applicants and those supporting the applicants.

The application and the materials filed in the interim shut in application include logs for approximately 80 wells. However, the Board observes that there are additional wells within and proximal to the region of influence identified by Sunshine for which no logs have yet been filed. As information derived from the associated well logs may be material and relevant to the proceeding it is the Board's intention to identify those wells so that interested parties may file evidence regarding those wells and answer any questions of the Board regarding those wells. Accordingly, the Board has decided to revise the filing schedule to accommodate this additional information.

The Board intends to provide interested parties with this list of wells during the week of September 28<sup>th</sup>. The Board will then organize a meeting amongst the parties to discuss the timing implications of including this information in the hearing. Following that meeting the Board will issue an amended notice of hearing with revised filing dates. **Parties should take notice that the applicants and those supporting the applicants are no longer required to file submissions on September 30, 2009.**

Finally, the Board advises that this change to the filing schedule for the final proceeding will not affect the Board's deliberations on the interim shut-in application.
