PRESSURE DATA COLLECTION
VARIATION OF GB 2003-28, Section 4 “Pressure Data Requirements”

Superman Resources Inc. requests an extension of the November 1, 2003 deadline for conducting and submission of pressure data to March 1, 2004 for the following reasons:

- Alberta Forest Service has guidelines encouraging producers to limit activities to the winter months, hence reducing the environmental impact on lease roads and well sites.
- Superman Resources Inc. expects to conduct in the order of eight (8) pressure surveys in the Chard and Thornbury areas. Costs associated with acquisition of data over the winter months are far less than using air assisted units for fall season work. An economic burden would be incurred should we be required to mobilize units for the collection of data prior to the November 1, 2003 deadline.
