INTERIM SHUT-IN ORDER 03-001
00/10-12-079-07W4/2, 00/11-24-079-08W4/0,
00/11-28-080-06W4/0, AND 00/07-14-080-07W4/2 WELLS

The Alberta Energy and Utilities Board (EUB) has reviewed the subject wells, which are listed in Schedule A of Interim Shut-in Order 03-001, and determined that the perforated intervals for these wells were addressed in *Decision 2003-023* (Appendix 1). The following table summarizes the decisions made respecting these wells.

Given that *General Bulletin 2003-28* states that decisions made respecting Wabiskaw-McMurray gas production from wells that were considered at the Chard-Leismer hearing (*Decision 2003-023*) are unaffected by Interim Shut-in Order 03-001, the EUB intends to remove these wells from the interim shut-in order in due course. Until that time this letter will serve as confirmation that these wells are no longer subject to the interim shut in order.
